Butterfly Polka

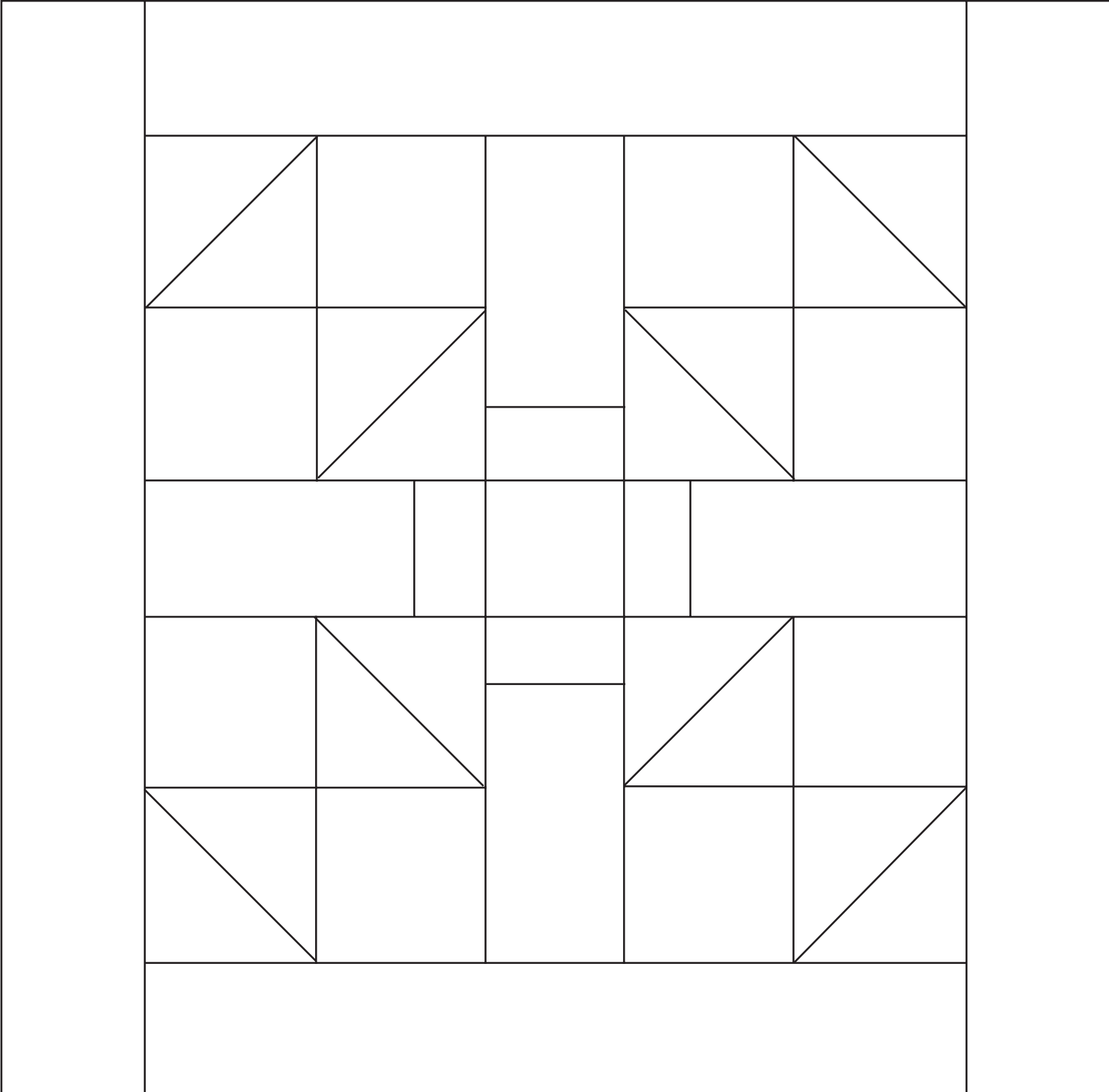

- Quilt size:** 8" x 8" (21cm x 21cm)
- You will need:** rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat, can spray starch, pink thread, pins, hand sewing needle
- Materials for block:** 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" strip yellow print, 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" strip orange print, 2 1/4" x 9" strip black print, 1 3/4" x 14" strip polka dot print
- Sashing:** 1 1/2" square red print, 2" x 6" black and white stripe (stripe running parallel with longest edge of strip *), 1" x 6" solid blue.
- Border:** 2 x 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips and 2 x 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips yellow print.
- Binding:** 1" x 35" strip pink solid.
- Batting:** 8 1/2" square Thinsulate™ batting
- Backing:** 8 1/2" square coordinating print
* You may like to allow a little extra fabric when using a stripe. This enables you to choose what part of the stripe meets the blue strip.

Construction:

1. Crosscut the polka dot print into eight 1 3/4" squares. Cut the black print in half. Spray lightly with spray starch on right side of yellow and orange fabrics. Lay the black fabric strips on top, right sides together and press. Cut each strip into two 2 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half once across the diagonal. Sew each of the pairs of triangles together with a scant 1/4" seam. Press seams lightly (it is best not to use steam until the piecing is finished) and trim tails. Trim squares to 1 3/4". Sew together a yellow/black unit to a polka dot square along the edge of the black triangle. Make four. Repeat with the orange/black unit. Make four units each with a yellow/orange unit and two polka dot squares. The orange and yellow triangles will be on opposite edges of the unit, with a black "butterfly" in the centre.
2. Sew the blue strip to the long edge of the black and white stripe. Sew together with the stripe uppermost, it helps in stitching a straight seam. Press seams towards stripe. Crosscut into four strips each 1 1/2" x 3".
3. Lay out the units as shown in the diagram, with yellow triangles and blue strips towards the centre. Pin sashing unit to each of two four patch units and sew together. Align the seams with the stripe. Press seam towards sashing. Repeat.
Sew a sashing unit to each side of the red centre square. Pin and sew the long sashing strip to the assembled units. Press seam towards sashing.
4. Sew the short border strips to opposite edges of the quilt. Press seams towards edge. Repeat with the long strips.
5. Sandwich the top, Thinsulate™, and backing together and pin. Quilt as desired. Stay stitch the edge of the quilt and trim.
6. Cut two 8" strips from the pink binding. With right sides together sew to top and bottom of the quilt with 1/4" seam. Fold binding to back of quilt and hand stitch in place. Cut two 8 1/2" strips from pink binding and repeat, folding the extra 1/4" fabric at either end over the raw edges. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.
